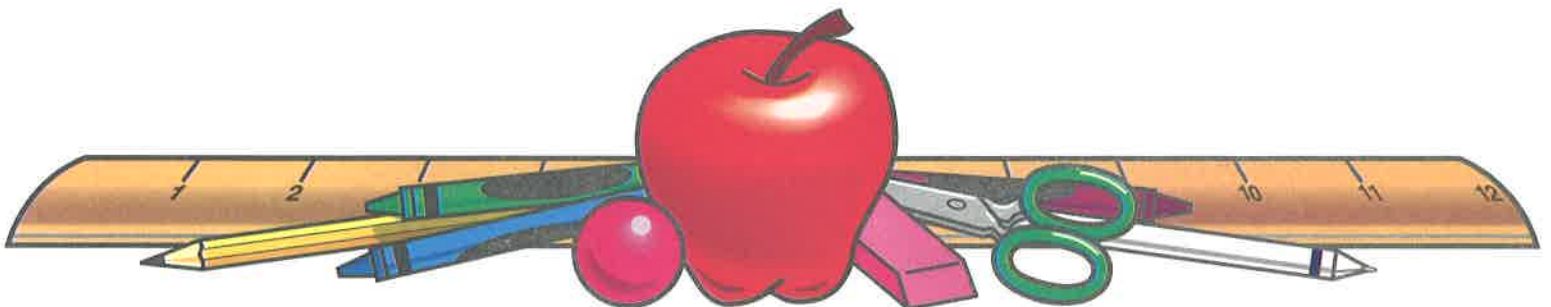
- ❖ Know your bus information

2nd Grade General Supply List



- 1- folder with pockets on the bottom- pick your favorite one, but make sure it is a sturdy / laminated one to hold daily classwork
 - 2- wide-ruled composition notebooks (they are usually marbled, but choose any one you like!)
 - 4- LARGE dry erase markers- odorless, basic colors (black/ blue/ red)
 - 1- ART smock (labeled with name and put in a gallon sized Ziplock bag)
YES!!! You can use an old t-shirt or the same one from last year if it still fits!
 - 5- JUMBO glue sticks (.74 oz.... they get used very quickly!)
 - 2- boxes regular school pencils- ***please sharpen them***
 - 1- set of ***inexpensive*** ear buds or headphones in a Ziplock bag with your child's name on it (if you have a working set from last year, you can reuse them)
 - 2- boxes of 24 crayons
 - 2- packs of post-it notes (1 ½ in X 2 in size AND 3 in X 3 in size)
